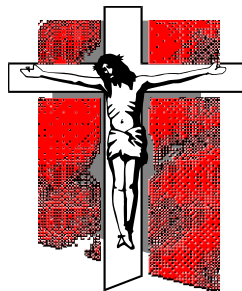

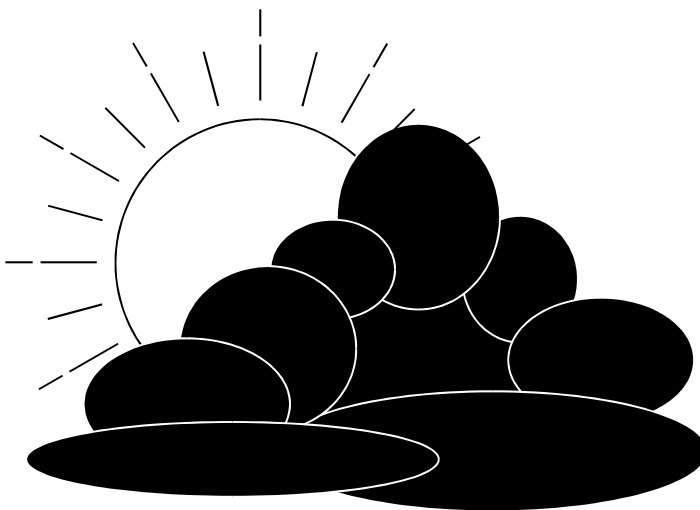


Faith

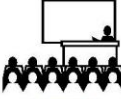

A RAY OF SUNSHINE

“I’ll be back!” was one of his favourite sayings. And he was, always coming back. He told me about his “pagan” past. I don’t know details but the Ray I knew didn’t live a chequered past!

Ray said the group before him was wiped out in Korea. Ray led a small group of soldiers into combat. “Big Boy” died before his eyes, and a Hispanic soldier disappeared during fighting. Ray and Barbara were watching a newsreel in a theatre after the war, when Ray spotted his heroic Spanish buddy in the news alive!

A bartender led him to the Catholic Church. He told Ray that he seemed unhappy and might like the Church. An Irish priest tossed Ray a book to read and brought Ray into the Church. Ray and others went door to door in Cypress looking for help to build St. Irenaeus Church.

I followed Ray in praying before a Planned Parenthood late term abortion “clinic” in Long Beach, California. Ray saved countless lives there. On one occasion when the air condition in my car hit him, Ray passed out and his eyes rolled around in his head. Sister Kathleen was in the back seat and supported his head as I raced to the hospital. They ran every test and determined he was severely dehydrated. After recovery he kept going back to save babies!

Ray served in the Knights of Columbus for years. He brought Holy Communion and support to the homebound in nursing homes for a while. He and his lovely wife Barbara celebrated 70 years in the sacrament of marriage. He loved his large family deeply and would give them the shirt off his back. He promised to keep praying for them after death!

Ray tried to get me to invest in gold or silver. He bought gold when it was \$250 per ounce! He told me about financing huge family gatherings to which he invited all their children and spouses along with 30 grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Ray and Barbara kept downsizing to make it easier for the family when God called them. For the last couple of years Ray’s bladder gave out. He had to join me in the wear a catheter club. I was able to recover, but Ray didn’t. He and Barbara walked a couple of blocks daily to mass. With his radiant smile he reached out to everyone around him to love them and pray for them, not to complain about his problems!

A priest told us not to canonize anyone at their funeral. I’ll bet there are hundreds or thousands who would disagree in Ray’s case! I do believe Ray has truly gone home at 97 on July 3, 2026!

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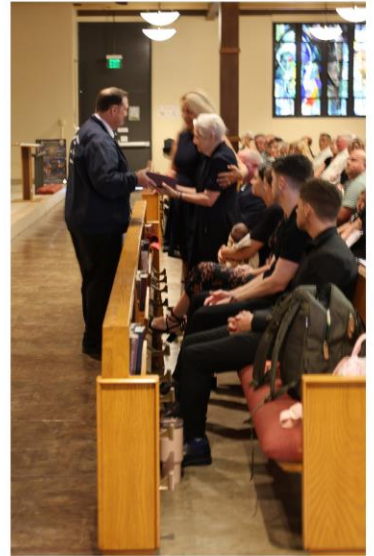
