I hope to see you all at the Pancake Breakfast.

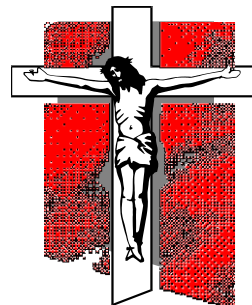

Jesus Prayer for Unity

The night before Jesus was crucified John recorded this prayer in his gospel. Jesus knew this might be His last words to His closest followers. He knew that they would have to carry His message not just to the ones within ear shot of His voice, but also to the ones that they would be carrying it to as well. He knew how hard it was going to be for them because they would be facing so much opposition. He was sending them out to **unify** the world for Christ, and some would hate them for it. *John 17:11 "Holy Father protect them by the power of your name-the name you gave me- so that they may be one as we are one." John 17: 20 "My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one." John 17:23 "May they be brought to complete **unity** to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me."* John 18:1 When he had finished praying Jesus left with his disciples and crossed the Kedron Valley. On the other side there was an olive grove, and he and his disciples went into it.

If you're interested in the whole **unity** prayer that Jesus prays the night before he is betrayed and then crucified, it is broken down in three parts. John 17:1-5 Jesus prays to the Father for himself. John 17:6-19 Jesus prays for His Disciple's. John 17:20-26 He prays for all believers. There will be an Officers training that will take place at St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, in Huntington Beach.

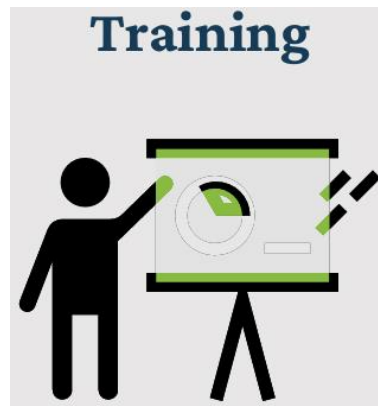
Wednesday, August 21st, 6:00PM (Social)/7 PM (Meeting)

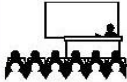

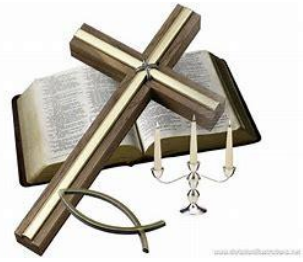

COMFORT INN

Sunday, January 28 was the last day of our 2024 three day retreat. At 7 am the volunteer bell ringer, who later that day received the “Ding Dong Award,” vigorously rang the bell in all the hallways. At 7:45 am we met in the chapel for Morning Prayer. At 8:10 am everyone entered the Dining Hall. Our scrumptious breakfast included scrambled eggs, large sausage patties, medium sized pancakes with butter and syrup, and fresh oatmeal with butter, brown sugar, and milk. We washed it down with coffee, orange juice, and water. Silence was still in force.

At 9:15 am we had our last conferences in Possenti Hall. Dr. Dan Van Dyke presented seven questions to be discussed in small groups. Each group addressed one question, and a spokesman presented the results to all. Dr. Dan and the Passionist Retreat Team have learned the effectiveness of the retreats through this exercise, which ended our silence. Whew!

Question #1 had the group examine the photograph on our retreat brochure of Jesus on the Crucifix atop the outdoor Stations of the Cross with the Sun rising in the background. Group #1 saw us beneath the Cross looking up toward God’s love and light for the world in Jesus!

Question #2 asked, “How does the Passion of Christ, particularly His willingness to endure suffering, offer comfort and empathy to individuals facing their own challenges and pain?” The group answered, “We are the Body of Christ who willingly suffer with Him.”

Question #3 queried, “Have you experienced any Gethsemane moments? What was your response?” The group’s answer was, “Jesus suffered due to the sins of His People and His Apostles’ failure to understand Him. The Apostles evolved into understanding and said, ‘Let not my will be done but Yours.’”

Question #4 said, “The Passion of Christ challenges conventional notions of success and power. How has this narrative influenced your own values and priorities? In what ways can it reshape societal values and priorities?” The group felt that the answer was self-evident from the question.

Question #5, our group’s, stated, “‘Standing at the foot of the Cross.’ How does being part of a community of believers impact one’s sense of identity and comfort, especially during times of isolation and loneliness?” Rolly said his Filipino Federation has learned to trust God and pray for others, some of whom have been healed by those prayers. Bill has found comfort in fellow retreatants at Mater Dolorosa who have all come for comfort. Joe had a rough time in 2023, but he has found comfort and blessing at St. Irenaeus Parish and Mater Dolorosa. Dave experienced comfort in Jesus becoming a weak human being to save us. John has found a powerful message in focusing with fellow believers that Christ died for all of us. I experienced the Community of Saints in the making and God’s presence in all believers.

Question #6 asked, “In what ways does the resurrection of the Crucified One provide hope and reassurance in the face of suffering and death? How does this hope differ from secular notions of optimism?” The group agreed that “We always have hope through Jesus, but secular notions of optimism comes and goes!”

Question #7 stated, “Name two or three insights from the retreat that you will take back with you. How might they change your spiritual disposition?” Their spokesman Rick said, “Because Christ’s suffering covered every suffering, we trust Him with our suffering. Mother Mary’s suffering was terrible, and she helps us through our suffering. We discovered a need to be present and to listen to everyone!”

After a ten minute break, Father Bruno led the Wrap-up session also at Possenti. He noted that today is musician Paul’s 53rd birthday. During the two years of COVID as Paul suffered from cancer, his neighbor Gary drove him to Mater Dolorosa chapel to play beautiful music as part of the live streamed services.

Father Bruno gave a brief biography of St. Paul of the Cross, founder of the Passionist Order. He was born in 1694 and grew up in a large family during a time of epidemics and much suffering. His mother was very strict and told Paul to focus on the “Man on the Cross.” She died when Paul was a child. Paul took the Blessed Virgin Mary as his mother. She came to him three times in visions wearing a black robe with the heart symbol on it. That symbol with a cross on top of the heart became the Passionist symbol.

Father Bruno outlined all the ministries at Mater Dolorosa for the year. At 11:30 am he celebrated mass in the chapel. Our spirits soared at the joyous singing of over 70 men and a few women. We sang “Happy Birthday” to surprise Paul, who became very emotional and had to sit down for a few moments. Departure was at 12:30 pm. On this bright sunny day, I drove Rick home as we reflected on our joyous weekend retreat.

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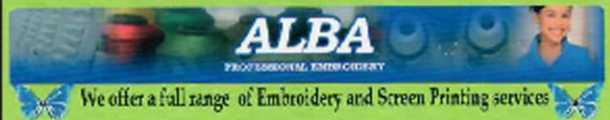
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
