One of the things I love about being catholic are the Liturgical Seasons. Even if you had no idea what was happening in the world around you or what day it is on the calendar, when you walk into church and see that the Curtains have been changed and the Priests are wearing different colors, you know that something has changed!

What rich Feast Days Advent offers us. November 30 is the feast of St. Andrew. Peter's younger brother who after his encounter with Jesus goes running to find Peter and breathlessly exclaims "We have found the Messiah!"

December 8 is the Feast of the Immaculate Conception where God set apart Mary at her conception with special Grace to enable her to align her will with God and say Yes to becoming the Mother of God! CHURCH MUSINGS

On Wednesday, November 9, 2022, the Catholic Church celebrated the Feast of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. In 324 AD Emperor Constantine, who became Christian, gave the Lateran Palace to the Pope. The Pope built his church on that very site in Rome.

Why celebrate a church? Why would the Lateran Basilica be so special? Father Aaron of St. Irenaeus tackled those questions in his homily. Each Catholic Church is dedicated by a bishop, who anoints the altar with holy oil which he blessed on Holy Thursday. The bishop also blesses the columns that support the church structure. But Sacred Scripture tells us that the People of God are the church; so what gives?

I started thinking that for Christians, the first church was the stable/cave where Baby Jesus was born. Why would the church building be so special? I remembered that in 2021 my wife and I were in an ancient Catholic Church in southern France. We were on a Viking Cruise, and two fellow travellers came in to visit the church. That was where we started talking to Nancy and Jeff who were on the trip with us. Nancy said she and Jeff were Jewish, but they always visit Catholic Churches on their travels. I wondered why. We bonded from that moment and continued to visit throughout our trip.

In my own life, I have experienced many different Catholic Churches, both rich and poor. In the fall 1947, I was baptized at St. Patrick's Church in Denison, Texas. In 2022 St. Patrick's celebrated its 150 year anniversary. It began as a humble wooden church but was destroyed by fire in 1911. In 1914 St. Patrick's was rebuilt in brick and has stood steadfast through the present. In the late 1960s, two other seminarians and I drove 90 miles from Holy Trinity Seminary outside Dallas to teach catechism classes each Monday night at the Catholic school there for one year. We celebrated both my parents' lives at a funeral mass at St. Patrick's in 2007.

Also in the 1960s, I travelled from the University of Dallas with a group of fellow students to spend two weeks in a remote village called Solidadita (meaning "lonely little" village.) It was in Morelia, Michoacan, Mexico, where we made adobe bricks one by one for a church that was going to be built in the future. We scraped moist earth near a dirt road, mixed it with cement and lime, and then we scooped it into an ancient mould. I never returned to see the church. I know the humble church there was just as important as the Lateran Basilica! In this poor remote village God was present in the People of God.

On our Viking cruises through Russia (2018), France (2021), and Germany, Austria, Slovakia, and Budapest (2022) we toured magnificent churches, basilicas, and cathedrals. All were holy places where the People of God worshipped, but none were more important than the small, simple church in Solidadita or the birthplace of Jesus over 2,000 years ago in Bethlehem!

As the Jewish people believed in Yahweh's presence in the Ark of the Covenant, Jesus gave us His presence at the Last Supper. He told his apostles and us to take and eat the bread and to drink the wine, which truly were His body and blood. They were the New Covenant God made with humanity. Could not God, who humbled Himself to become man, again humble Himself in the host and wine at mass?

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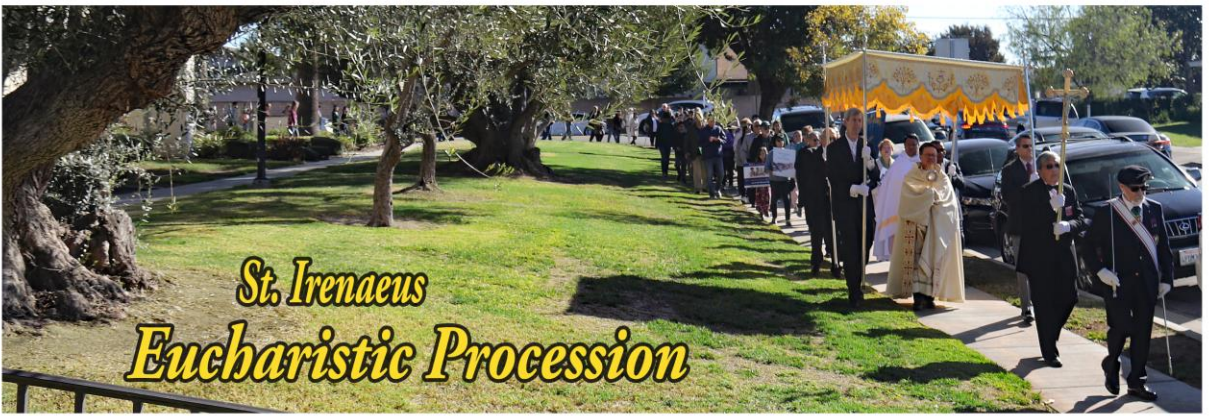


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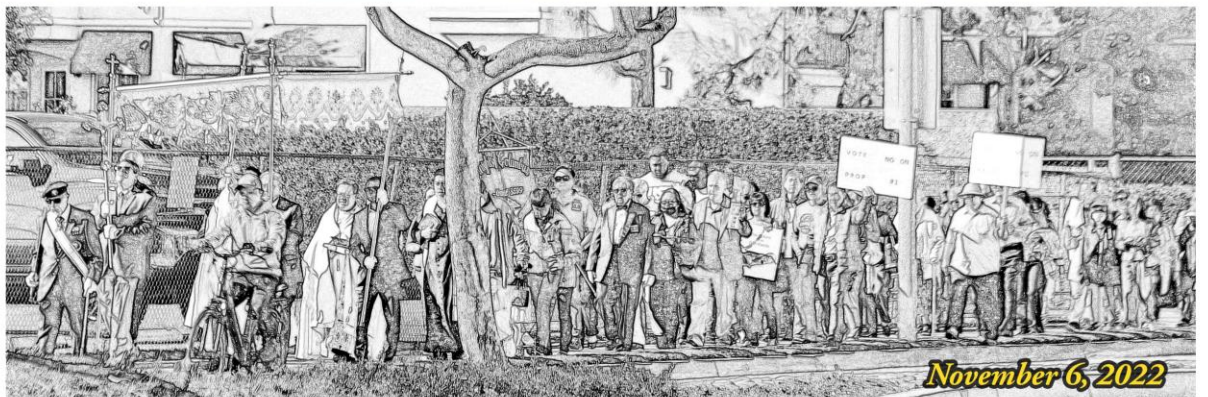

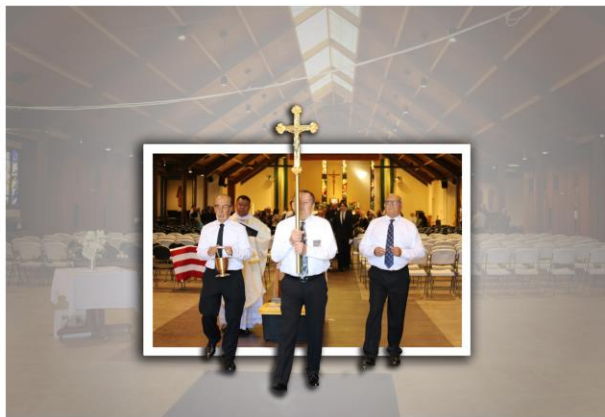
