Dear Brother Knight's

The Tale of Two Cities Platforms

The party strongly and unequivocally supports Roe v. Wade and a woman's right to make decisions regarding her pregnancy, including a safe and legal abortion, regardless of ability to pay. We oppose any and all efforts to weaken or undermine that right. Abortion is an intensely personal decision between a woman, her family, her doctor, and her clergy; there is no place for politicians or government to get in the way. We also recognize that health care and education help reduce the number of unintended pregnancies and thereby also reduce the need for abortions. We strongly and unequivocally support a woman's decision to have a child by providing affordable health care and ensuring the availability of and access to programs that help women during pregnancy and after the birth of a child, including caring adoption programs.

Faithful to the "self-evident" truths enshrined in the Declaration of Independence, we assert the sanctity of human life and affirm that the unborn child has a fundamental individual right to life which cannot be infringed. We support a human life amendment of the Constitution and endorse legislation to make clear that the Fourteenth Amendment's protections apply to unborn children. We oppose using public revenues to promote or perform abortion or fund organizations which perform or advocate it and will not fund or subsidize health care which includes abortion coverage. We support the appointment of judges who respect traditional family values and the sanctity of innocent human life. We oppose the nonconsensual withholding or withdrawal of care or treatment, including food and water, from people with disabilities, including newborns, as well as the elderly and infirm, just as we oppose active and passive euthanasia and assisted suicide.

Presenting the third Catholic Social Teaching (CST) of the U.S. Catholic Bishops:

THEME # 3 Rights and Responsibilities

The Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and responsibilities are met. Therefore, every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities--to one another, to our families, and to the larger society.

Scripture

Leviticus 25:35 - When someone is reduced to poverty, we have an obligation to help.

Ruth 2:2-23 - Boaz cares for Ruth, a widow and a foreigner, giving her far more than the law requires.

Tobit 4:5-11 - Give from what you have received and do not turn away from the poor.

Proverbs 31:8-9 - Open your mouth to speak on behalf of those in need.

Isaiah 1:16-17 - Seek justice, rescue the oppressed, defend the orphan, plead for the widow.

Jeremiah 22:13-16 - A legitimate government upholds the rights of the poor and vulnerable.

Jeremiah 29:4-7 - Seek the welfare of the city, for in its welfare you will find your welfare.

Matthew 25:31-46 - Just as you did it to the least of these, you did it to me.

2 Corinthians 9:6-15 - God's gifts are given to be shared.

Dear Brothers,

With half the Columbian year behind us, it is now time to focus on recruiting that future member that you have in mind. There are many men that I see at mass that are not Brother Knights, maybe they have not been asked to join our order. I know some that have been asked but tell me to ask them after the New Year. Some say no but believe it or not they may change their mind by observing what our order is doing around the parish. You know the old saying, if you don't ask, he'll never join. I have had wives come to me and tell me they want their husbands to join, but no one has ever asked him. That's the time to take her information and contact him.

I have some names that a few of you Brothers have gave me and you might be wondering why they have not joined yet, well the ones I did contact told me to wait till after the 1st of the year, so I will be busy contacting them and paying them a visit. Proposing a new member is a commendable achievement and one to be proud of. However, as a proposer, turning over a completed Membership Document (#100) is not the end of the job. 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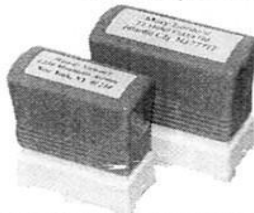

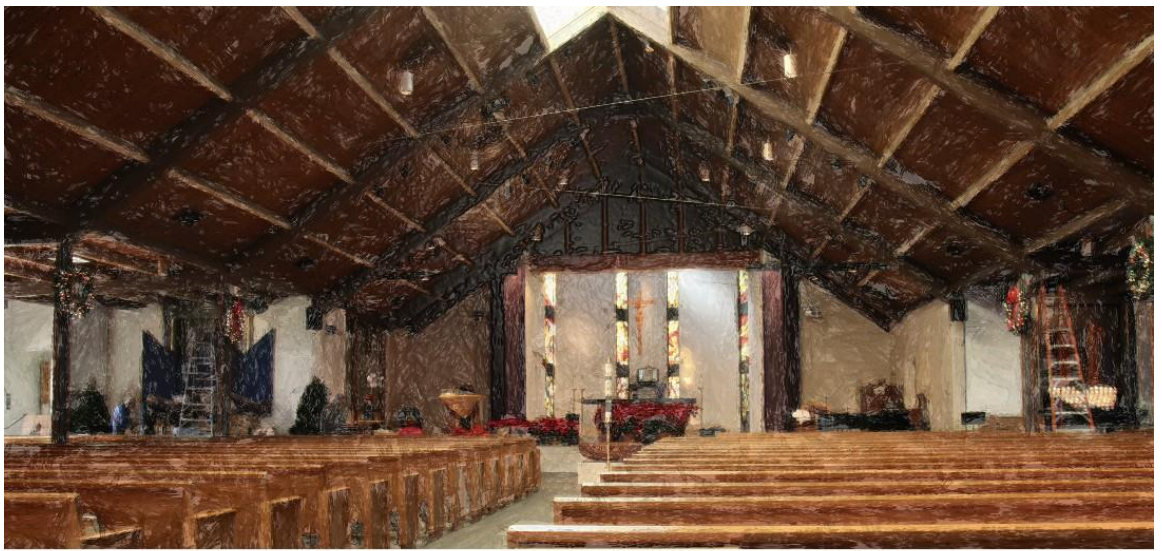
