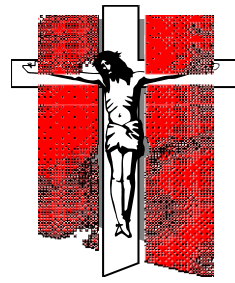

“Oh Give Thanks”

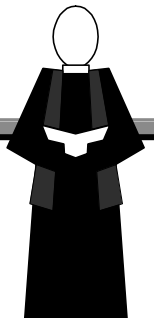

FINANCIAL SECRETARY



Dear Brother Knights,

Congratulations to Jerry Baldwin whose name drawn for the Good of the Order drawing at the Member Meeting in December. Unfortunately, he wasn't present to collect \$60.00. The January drawing will increase to **\$70. You must be present to win.**

Dues Statements for 2021 calendar year have been sent out. In addition to our \$32.00 dues, there are 3 special assessments included. *If you are having financial difficulties in paying your dues, please contact either myself or Grand Knight Rick Tkach as we can help you remain a Council Member in good standing.*

The 1st special assessment is for **Columbian Charities**, in the amount of only **\$3.65**. **California Columbian Charities, Inc.** is dedicated to assisting California Brothers in financial distress, including their widows. It has responded to almost 2100 requests for assistance from Brother Knights in California and has given over \$3,000,000 in relief. Columbian Charities provides financial assistance to Knights of Columbus Brothers, with at least twelve months good standing in a California Council; and to their widows and orphans, by helping to relieve financial distress due to unemployment, sickness, family medical and hospital bills, overdue rent or mortgage payments, property tax, food, clothing, losses due to fire, flood or earthquake. All the financial assistance provided is a grant and need not be repaid. *If you know a Brother Knight who is in need of assistance, contact our Grand Knight, who can obtain a Charity application from the California State Council office.* So please include the **\$3.65** added to your dues.

The 2nd is the Knights of Columbus **Culture of Life Fund**, is a permanent fund established by a vote of the delegates to the 2008 Supreme Convention in Quebec City. As of December 2016, the initiative has funded and placed 829 ultrasound machines, valued at more than \$40 million, in all 50 states, as well as in Canada, Jamaica, Guatemala and Peru, and helped save the lives of thousands of babies. So please include the **\$2.00** added to your dues.

The 3rd is **Council Brothers in Financial Difficulty**, which is a Council fund established last year following the founding Principle of our Order, Charity, to assist Council Brothers in financial difficulty in keeping their dues current. So please include the **\$5.00** added to your dues.

Fraternal Activities Survey forms were emailed in December. Please complete yours and return with your 2021 dues by the January Member Meeting, as its data is needed by the Supreme Council for documentation for the IRS to maintain 501(c) (3) Charitable Organization status.

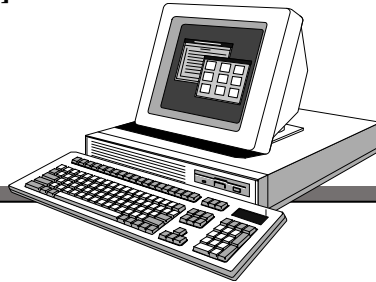

But we humans have adjusted to the radical changes by wearing masks everywhere and keeping apart. I never would have imagined not being allowed into a bank or restaurant or even Home Depot without a mask. Before 2020 everyone would have dropped to the floor and yelled, "Holdup!"

Corona Virus has robbed us of much, but it hasn't stolen our hope. Look at the positive signs: cleaner air, freer freeways, closer relations with family and friends. Our first grandchild is due soon. Many of us have just celebrated the birth of a very special child over 2,000 years ago.
