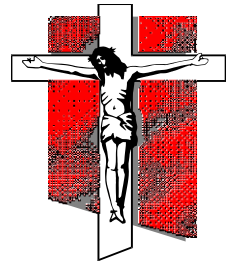

Replace Anxiety for Trust

With everything that is going on in the news these days it's easy to be anxious about the direction this world is moving in. But Paul wrote in *Philippians 4: 6-7* "*Do not be anxious about anything, but in prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God and the peace of God, which transcends all understanding will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*"

Now if you follow that up with Psalms 37 David gives a clear picture of the same thing that Paul is talking about. Don't worry, God is in control. Trust Him.

Psalms 37

Do not fret because of evil men or be envious of those who do wrong; 2.for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away. 3. Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. 4. Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart.5. Commit your way to the Lord trust in Him and He will do this: 6.He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun.7. Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for Him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes.8. Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret-it leads only to evil.9. For evil men will be cut off, but those who hope in the Lord will inherit the land. 10. a little while and the wicked will be no more; though you look for them, they will not be found. 11. But the meek will inherit the land and enjoy great peace. 12. The wicked plot against the righteous and gnash their teeth at them; 13. But the Lord laughs at the wicked, for He knows their day is coming. 14. The wicked draw the sword and bend the bow to bring down the poor and needy, to slay those whose ways are upright. 15. But the swords will pierce their own hearts, and their bows will be broken.16.Better the little the righteous have than the wealth of many wicked; 17.for the power of the wicked will be broken, but the Lord upholds the righteous. (Continue reading in your bible through verse 40).

Psalms continues thru verse 40 with the message that God has everything under control. There is nothing going on that He is not aware of. Trust in Him.

HELPERS

Mr. Fred Roger's mom told him to "look for the helpers" in every disaster. Every day I have prayed for doctors, nurses, and medical staff who have helped me throughout my life and prevented disasters!

Dr. Kitrel (deceased) helped Mom deliver me at Madonna Hospital in Texas 75 years ago. An unknown surgeon and staff at Madonna repaired my hernia when I was only six years old. I thought I could jump on my bike from the rear just like cowboys mounted their horses in movies. Ouch! An assortment of doctors and nurses helped me recover from childhood diseases. I have no idea how many doctors did exams on me for school and work. Red Cross nurses have always helped me and countless others while donating blood, etc.

A nurse at the U.S. Post Office gave us new employees great advice on basic morning hygiene! Another nurse, Maxine Cocking, came several times to the Los Angeles Asylum Office. We cracked up when she shared her concern before going there. She was working in the Federal building in Santa Ana, CA and was told that she was going to the Asylum Office, which was headed by Mr. Looney. Nurse Maxine gave us shots, checked our blood pressure, and tested us for diseases that might come from applicants from all over the world. She told us that when she was a young, pregnant nurse working in an emergency room, an older man with TB collapsed. She feared he might die and gave him mouth to mouth resuscitation. She never got TB but has always tested positive for it because of her heroic act!

It seems that dedicated doctors and nurses put themselves at risk for the sake of their patients. Somewhere I read that dentists tend to die young because of all the pain they see daily in their work. Dr. Ernst, my former dentist in Anaheim, CA, wasn't much over 50 when he died.

Of my most endearing doctors for whom I pray was Dr. Gracia (not Garcia.) On December 19, 1966, he performed plastic surgery on my face and right hand that were both cut deeply. The driver with whom I was riding raced around a curve in Fort Worth, Texas and lost control of his 1960 Ford Falcon, which slammed into a neighbourhood tree at 37 miles per hour. I was in the front passenger seat and must have put my hand over my eyes. The five anonymous blood donors whose pints of blood saved my life during surgery were also my heroes, as well as the family who raced out of their home to give us first aid and to call ambulances!

My aunt, Catholic nun Sister Martha, gave me a newspaper article she found on Dr. Gracia, who grew up poor in Mexico. The article reported that he travelled to Mexico with a medical team once a year to repair cleft palates of young and old poor folks. In my case, he performed a second! [Continued on Page 13]

I have always felt the guidance of something else that cannot be shown visibly. It is a deep faith that I hold and hope to be an example of. When I had my heart attack several years ago, I was concerned obviously, but not afraid. Weird to say, but I was not alone. It is an honor to be with the company of many brave Knights.

surgery on my face one year later to make sure all the glass was gone from my wounds. Dr. Gracia only charged what my dad's insurance paid!

I have prayed too for a husband and wife team of doctors of osteopathy in Fort Worth, Texas. I had been experiencing lower back pain for some time. The doctors took several X-rays. I had an irregular curvature of the spine at its bottom, stemming from birth or a fall. They gave me a simple exercise of lying on a stack of books covered with a towel and resting my feet on a couch. That pressed the spine off of the nerve causing the pain! Drugs were not needed.

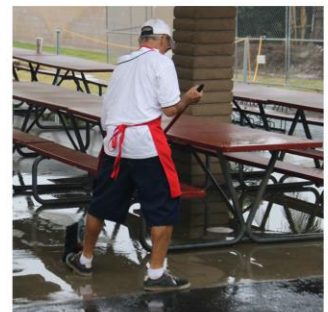
